INFORMATION FOR DELEGATES

The 2022 Conference is a mixed format of remote and in-person attendance. Key conference events take place offline with an option of online participation. The conference will speak to teaching professionals, researchers, experts in practical and applied psychology, post-graduate and undergraduate students from universities and secondary technical and vocational schools.

Participation options:

- Presentation with a subsequent publication of a paper;
- Presentation without a subsequent publication of a paper;
- Participation without a presentation or subsequent publication of a paper (non-presenting delegates).
 Please note that in 2022 a publication in conference proceedings is possible only for presenting delegates with positive refereeing decisions.

Participation certificates. Presenting delegates will obtain a relevant electronic certificate of a speaker. Non-presenting delegates will obtain a relevant electronic certificate of an attendee.

Conference proceedings. Accepted papers are published in electronic Conference Proceedings. The materials are indexed in Russian Index of Science Citation (RISC) and CrossRef. Proceeding of past conferences are available at the Conference website https://herzenpsyconf.ru/materialy-konferencei/ for author guidelines. All the submissions to the Conference Proceedings will be liable to scrutiny in the Antiplagiat system to identify plagiarism. We also operate a double-blind peer review process. The submissions are checked for the compliance with the conference topics, reliability of research outcomes, style and formatting.

How to become a delegate:

1. Register at the Conference website at https://herzenpsyconf.ru/

Please note that registration is compulsory. Links to online sessions and certificates of The Herzen University Conference on Psychology in Education — 2022 will be available to registered delegates only.

Registration opens **1 May 2022.** Presenting delegates are required to submit a 250-300 word abstract of a conference paper. Registration for presenting delegates closes **25 July 2022.** Authors are informed about the decision of the Programme Committee no later than **10 August 2022.**

- 2. If necessary, submit a complete manuscript no later than **10 September 2022** provided the Programme Committee has accepted the abstract.
- 3. Register as a non-presenting delegate no later than 4 October 2022.

Organisation fee:

- Presentation with a subsequent publication of a paper—1,800 Rub.
- Presentation without a subsequent publication of a paper—600 Rub.
- Participation without a presentation or subsequent publication of a paper (non-presenting delegates)—**free of charge**.

The participation fee includes attendance, an electronic participation certificate, a publication in Conference Proceedings, and an option of uploading a video with the delegates' presentation on the Conference website (with the delegate's consent). **The organisation fee is payable no later than 1 October 2022.** Participation fee is not applicable to keynote speakers. Keynote speakers may publish their paper either in the Conference Proceedings or in the journal "Psychology in Education" (included in the list of peer-reviewed journals approved by Russia's Ministry of Science and Higher Education for the publication of results of doctoral research).
